Eight questions I always get asked about Blue:

How old is Blue? Blue is 3 years old. He will be 4 years old on January  $\mathbf{6}^{\text{th}}$ 

What does Blue like to eat? Blue's favorite food is hot dogs. Those are a special treat we use for training. For dinner every day, Blue eats dog kibble.

What is Blue's favorite game? Blue's favorite thing to play is chasing balls or sticks. He will play that ALL DAY LONG!

Does Blue live with other dogs? Blues lives with 2 other little dogs and a cat.

Where does Blue sleep? Blue sleeps on a special dog mat beside my bed. He likes to be close to "his" people.

Does Blue like to swim? YES!! Blue loves it if you throw a stick into the water so he can swim out to get the stick.

Will Blue bite me? No! Blue had to pass 2 tests to be a therapy dog that works with children. He gets very excited when he knows he is going "to work" because he loves seeing all the children at school.

Can Blue go everywhere you go? No, but that would be fun! Therapy dogs are not like service dogs. They cannot go into stores or restaurants. They are just like a regular dog but have passed a test to make sure they are extra friendly and well behaved.

## SchoolCashOnline Step-by-step sheet for parents/guardians

For safety and efficiency reasons, Abbotsford School District would like to reduce the amount of cash & cheques coming into our school. Please join the thousands of parents who have already registered and are enjoying the convenience of paying ONLINE! It takes less than 5 minutes to register. Please follow these step-by-step instructions, so you will begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren).

NOTE: If you require assistance, select the GET HELP option in the top right hand corner of the screen.

#### Step 1: Register

- a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page <u>https://abbotsford.schoolcashonline.com</u> and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps
   \*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

#### Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

#### Step 3: Find Student

#### Note: Student Number is Not Required

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name
- b) Enter the School Name
- c) Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- d) Select Continue
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue
- f) Your child has been added to your account

#### Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" option and repeat the steps above. 5 children can be added to one parent account.

If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.

Note: all information is stored on a confidential basis on a server in Canada.
